WORKSHOPS

WHAT? Workshops are based on the *Words Come Alive!* techniques that have been developed by the Flynn Center teaching artists in collaboration with local teachers over the last several years. These workshops use drama and/or movement activities to deepen your students' understanding of literature, history, math or science.

WHAT IS POSSIBLE? On the other side, see list of topics that the Flynn teaching artists will focus upon. Requests for other topics are invited.

HOW LONG? The workshops are an hour long.

HOW MANY? Because of the highly interactive nature of the workshops, participation is limited to 25 students. There is a minimum of **two** workshops per day per teaching artist, so teachers working in the same school need to coordinate the timing of workshops that are led by one teaching artist.

COST? \$100 per workshop plus mileage outside of Chittenden County (.505/mile)
\$90 per workshop if you book 6 or more
